All states and territories in Australia until recently have based their confined space requirements on the Australian Standard AS/NZS 2865:2001. Due to the update of this Australian Standard to AS 2865:2009 Confined Spaces in September 2009 it has become necessary for all currently trained confined space workers to receive update training to understand their obligations. This is immediate for Queensland workers as AS 2865 is inscribed in Qld WH&S Regulation 2008 as is. Other states will have to follow suite as soon as new regulations are published for that state. A simple way to achieve this is to have workers attend a one day Reassessment course asap. Regular reassessment is a requirement under the legislation.

We offer special discounts to assist with this update reassessment issue in the form of quantity discounts as listed above.

A prerequisite for this course is providing evidence of previously (within a reasonable time prior to this course) having completed Nationally Recognised confined space training.

This is a reassessment course consisting of two competencies, BCCM2009B - Work in confined spaces and its prerequisite BCCCM2001C - Follow OH&S policies and procedures are from the construction training package and follow the requirements of AS 2865:2009 very closely. As AS 2865 is inscribed in the QLD WHS Regulations and forms the basis for all other state and territory WHS Regulations and require regular reassessments to maintain your skills and competency. Industry norm for reassessment are between 12 and 24 months.

This course refresh trainees to comply with their legal obligations and retest their understanding of safe work in confined space requirements.

This course is delivered over a one day period(7.45am - 4pm each day) and consists of refresher training modules covering the Legislation, Confined Space definition, Risk Assessment, Permits, Rescue, Confined Space equipment including gas detectors.
